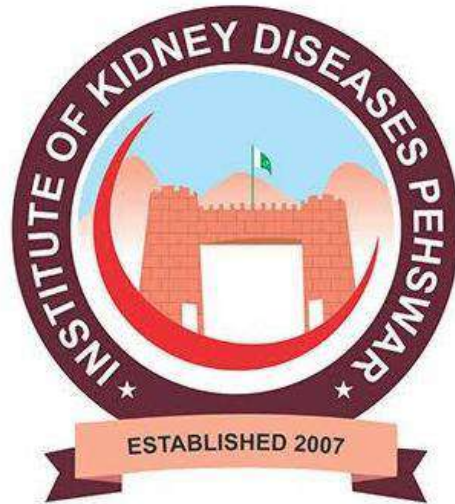

**NEWSLETTER DESCRIPTION:**

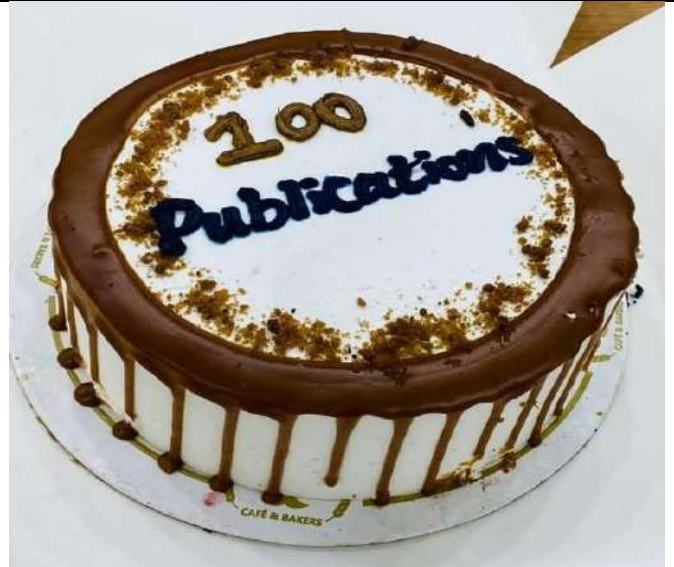

**INAUGURATION OF NEW 5-BEDDED GENERAL ICU AT IKD:**

The Institute of Kidney Diseases (IKD) is pleased to announce the addition of a new 5-bedded General Intensive Care Unit (ICU) to its healthcare facility. On August 8, 2025, the newly established ICU was formally inaugurated by the Hon'ble Members Board of Governors MTI-HMC Malik Akhtar Hussain Awan, Malik Saddique Awan, and Prof. Dr. Shahzad Akbar Khan Dean of MTI Khyber Girls Medical College Peshawar in a brief but significant ceremony.

On this occasion, the Director IKD highlighted that the institute currently operates two ICUs— one dedicated to transplant patients and the other for general cases. Given the limited capacity of the existing general ICU, which comprises only five beds, it has been insufficient to handle the growing patient load effectively.

The addition of this new 5-bedded ICU is a significant step toward enhancing critical care services and improving patient management. Furthermore, the existing general ICU will now be repurposed as a High Dependency Unit (HDU), thereby optimizing the use of available resources for better patient outcomes.

This development marks another milestone in IKD's continued efforts to provide quality and accessible healthcare to the public.
